

Sitton Peak Hike



Description:

We begin in the parking lot across the street from the Ortega Oaks Candy Store (34950 Ortega Highway, Lake Elsinore, CA 92530, 951-678-5406). At 3,273 feet above sea level, **Sitton Peak** has commanding 360 degree views of the Cleveland National Forest. On clear days, you can see the ocean and even Catalina Island. The elevation gain and distance makes this a good intermediate level hike. Distance: 5 miles to the peak, 5 miles back. Elevation gain: 2,150 feet.

When:

Meet March 9 @7:00 am at in the parking lot across from the Candy Store. We should be back at the cars by 4pm.

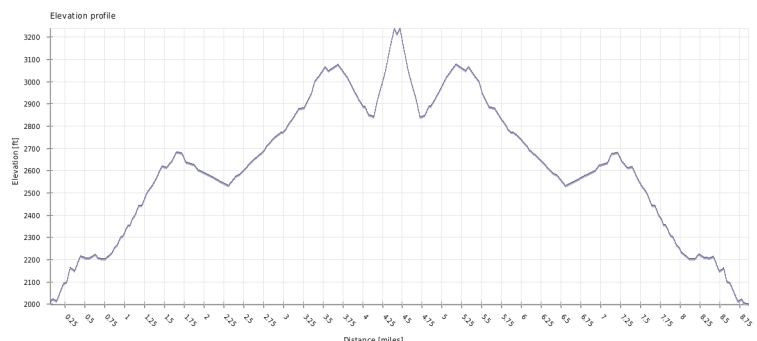

Take I-5 south to Ortega Highway (Highway 74). Head inland (East) ~19 miles. When you reach the candy store (on the right), turn left into the parking lot. There is no cell phone reception there, so bring an offline map with you. Parking requires an Adventure Pass.

Bring:

- Daypack & 10 essentials
- Map: 7.5-minute Sitton Peak
- HAT Blue Card
- Trail may be muddy in places
- Extra socks/sandals for ride home?
- Water, 3 liters Min.
- Snacks, lunch, and beverages of your choice
- Boots
- Personal Items (tissue, jacket, bug repellent, etc.)
- CLASS A Uniform, please** (for photos)
